



Information and Rules for Mercy's 2026 Bless Fest

HOURS: Bless Fest Hours are Saturday, May 2nd and Sunday, May 3rd from 9 am till 4 pm. Setup begins on Friday, May 1st at 10am and ends at 9am Saturday. There is 24 hr security for those who want to set up late Friday or early Saturday. Vendors should be ready for business by 9am Saturday.

DISPLAYS/BOOTH: Crafters/Vendors must supply their own tables, chairs and coverings/canopy. The Fest Chair reserves the right to have any item or exhibit removed which is determined to be in bad taste or has not been previously approved.

BOOTH SIZE: All booths are **OUTSIDE** and will be approximately 12'x12'. If additional space is required, 2 spaces should be reserved.

SALES TAX: Vendors will be responsible for reporting and paying their own applicable sales tax.

NOT ALLOWED: Alcohol, drugs and pets.

FOOD: Meals will be available for purchase.

ISSUES REQUIRING RESOLUTION: To be brought to the Fest Chair for a decision.

PARKING: Vendors/Crafters must provide the committee the planned vehicle type and whether a trailer will be pulled to plan for fest parking requirements.

FEES: Early Bird Special before December 1st \$90 per 12'x12' space.
After December 1st is the regular fee of \$100 per 12'x12' space.
After April 3rd late registration is \$125 per 12'x12' space.
Applications will not be accepted after April 19th
